

## Serial Number Information

<b>Position</b>	<b>Meaning</b>
<b>Digits</b>	<b>Pre-1992:</b>
<b>BEFORE</b>	Week or month of manufacture, either correct or reversed depending
<b>the letter</b>	on model and year. "72" could be either 27th week or 2nd month (ignore the 7.)

### **Post-1992:**

Month of manufacture. Could be represented as single digit

### **NOTE:**

Dates indicate when the radio was scheduled to be manufactured, not when it actually was ... the actual date of manufacture could be one or two months later.

<b>Letter</b>	Separator. "C" from 2000 on. "A", "B" or "H" before.
<b>First digit AFTER</b>	Production run number within the month (or week in early SN's)
<b>Next three digits</b>	Sequence number within the production run.
<b>Last digit</b>	Last digit of year of manufacture.

### **So that .. 12C10480**

: Scheduled to be manufactured December 2000, Run 1, #048, but may have been built a month or two later.
